

Austurvegur 44B, also known as Brekka, is one of the oldest houses in Seyðisfjörður. It is owned by an artist, and Skaftfell rents it for its residency artists during part of the year.

The house has three floors: on the ground floor are a single bedroom, the bathroom with shower and washing machine, and a storage room used by the house's owner. On the first floor are the living/working area (circa 15 m²), and the kitchen. Above, there is a sleeping loft with a double mattress.

This residency house is suitable for artists working mainly on research, with digital media, or in a way that doesn't require a big workspace.
